

3-DAY MT GAMBIER

Day 1:

Departing Melbourne in the morning we travel along the Princes Highway, passing the towns of **Geelong**, **Colac** and **Warrnambool**. We will stop in Warrnambool to have lunch (at own expense).

Soon after lunch, we will visit **Tower Hill** as we drive thru, we can admire the scenery in and around the area. We then head towards **Heywood** on our way to Mount Gambier. Upon arrival, we will check into the motel and freshen up before dinner (Dinner included at **RSL Club**)

Day 2:

After breakfast, we will take you to one of the most unique natural wonders on earth - the [Blue Lake](#), which is in a volcanic crater on the edge of the city. The lake changes colour each year to a brilliant blue in the spring and back to a blue-grey in the autumn.

We will visit **Valley Lake** and **Centenary Tower**, then we take you to [Port McDonnell](#) to see wagon tracks and [Cape Northumberland](#).

We stop for lunch, and soon after that we'll visit [Umpherston Sinkhole](#) before heading back to our motel to freshen up and enjoy your dinner (Dinner Included at RSL Club)

Day 3:

Departing Mount Gambier in the morning, we travel along the **Great Ocean Road**, where we pass the town of Warrnambool. We stop at the [Allansford Cheese World](#) – the Cheese World Museum. Soon after we have purchased the goods, we'll head towards the **Bay of Islands** for photos stop, then onto **London Bridge** and **Port Campbell** for lunch (at own expense).

Soon after lunch, we'll visit **Loch Ard Gorge**, then the [12 Apostles](#) before continuing our journey back home via Inland Route to Colac arriving in Melbourne around 18.30
